



Certain Weapons Statement

Lockheed Martin conducts business globally in a manner consistent with our core values of Do What's Right, Respect Others and Perform with Excellence, and in accordance with all U.S. Government regulations and policies, including those of export control, as well as all other applicable laws in all jurisdictions where we conduct business.

Our company does not develop, produce or distribute prohibited cluster munitions as defined by the U.S. Government, or the 2008 Convention on Cluster Munitions. We have no involvement in the production or stockpiling of anti-personnel landmines, and we are not involved in activities prohibited by U.S. law or policy involving biological or chemical weapons, incendiary weapons or non-detectable fragment weapons.

As the prime flight system integrator, Lockheed Martin supports U.S. and United Kingdom nuclear deterrence through the longstanding fleet ballistic missile (FBM) program. Lockheed Martin is an active partner to the U.S. Navy in the design, manufacture, assembly, testing, deployment, and sustainment of the FBM flight system while activating and maintaining associated support facilities, which complements our role as systems integrator with the Air Force for the MK21A re-entry vehicle. However, we do not manufacture the nuclear warhead and do not manufacture other ammunition with depleted uranium.
